Lynx Residence Sets the Standard for Green Residential Architecture

Everyone needs a quiet place to escape from the distractions that bog us down and interfere with our time with the ones we love. For the Lynx family, Crestone, Colo., is where they go when they find themselves in need of a retreat.
